**REPLY OF PACIFICORP (U-901-E) TO PROTEST OF DIVISION OF RATEPAYER
ADVOCATES**

Pursuant to Rule 2.6(e) of the Rules of Practice and Procedure (“Rules”) of the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), PacifiCorp, d.b.a. Pacific Power (“PacifiCorp” or “Company”), respectfully submits this reply to the Protest of the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (“DRA”) to PacifiCorp’s Application for an Order Authorizing a General Rate Increase Effective January 1, 2011 (“Application”).

I. REPLY TO DRA PROTEST

DRA’s Protest of December 23, 2009 does not dispute any authority sought by PacifiCorp to increase its rates for electric service. Rather, DRA indicates that it is reviewing PacifiCorp’s Application and the direct testimonies of PacifiCorp’s witnesses and points to the need for more time to conduct discovery, analyze and evaluate a number of preliminary issues outlined in the Protest. PacifiCorp is scheduled to meet with DRA on January 11, 2010 to discuss the Application and begin to address the preliminary issues set forth in the Protest.

PacifiCorp also understands the need for DRA to conduct discovery, analyze and evaluate PacifiCorp's Application and testimony.

PacifiCorp will not otherwise comment upon or reply to the issues specified in DRA's Protest as DRA has not at this time disputed the rates proposed by PacifiCorp or otherwise objected to the evidentiary support offered by PacifiCorp for its Application. PacifiCorp reserves the right to respond to DRA at an appropriate time in the future should DRA adopt a position in opposition to the rates or revenue requirement proposed in this Application, whether it be through testimony or other appropriate pleadings.

DRA also suggests that the inclusion of workshops in PacifiCorp's proposed schedule is unnecessary. PacifiCorp has no objection to this suggestion and is committed to working with DRA to develop a mutually agreeable case schedule, which PacifiCorp hopes can be finalized in the coming weeks.

II. CONCLUSION

PacifiCorp respectfully provides this reply to DRA's Protest and looks forward to addressing the issues set forth therein.


