Pacific Power ("PacifiCorp" or "Company"), respectfully submits this reply to the Response of the Division of Ratepayer Advocates ("DRA") to PacifiCorp's Application to Recover Costs Recorded in the Catastrophic Event Memorandum Account ("Application").

**I. DISCUSSION**


DRA's Protest of June 11, 2010 identifies a list of issues concerning the Application that DRA intends to audit. PacifiCorp agrees that the issues listed by DRA are appropriate for consideration and intends to work closely with DRA to facilitate all necessary discovery and examination of the Application. As an initial step in that process, DRA is scheduled to conduct an on-site audit at PacifiCorp's offices in Portland, Oregon beginning on June 24, 2010.

PacifiCorp will not otherwise comment upon or reply to the issues specified in DRA's Protest as DRA has not at this time disputed the rates proposed by PacifiCorp or otherwise objected to the evidentiary support offered by PacifiCorp for its Application. PacifiCorp reserves the right to respond to DRA at an appropriate time in the future should DRA adopt a position in opposition to the rates proposed in the Application, whether it be through testimony or other appropriate pleadings.

## II. CONCLUSION

PacifiCorp is committed to working with DRA to facilitate an appropriate examination of the Application. Based on the foregoing, PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Application in a timely manner.


