

## Appliances

Pacific Power provides incentives for many types of energy efficient technologies. Please read the following sections carefully to ensure that you follow the appropriate steps for securing your incentive.

Incentives for additional measures may be available. ### **HIGH-EFFICIENCY CLOTHES WASHER (COMMERCIAL)**

**Measure Description:** A commercial clothes washer is used in a Laundromat or other commercial laundry facility and often is a coin-operated machine. Clothes washers that have earned the ENERGY STAR® rating are more efficient than models that simply meet the federal minimum standard for energy efficiency.

**Applicability:** New construction and retrofit installations are eligible for an incentive via a post-purchase application process.

**Equipment Eligibility:** Equipment must be purchased and installed in a facility with electric water heating, and meet all other program terms and conditions. Incentives are available for equipment that is ENERGY STAR or Consortium for Energy Efficiency (CEE) Tier 2 qualified.

**HIGH-EFFICIENCY CLOTHES WASHERS (RESIDENTIAL USED IN BUSINESS)**

**Measure Description:** A residential clothes washer is a consumer product designed to clean clothes in a single family residence. Clothes washers that have earned the ENERGY STAR® rating are more efficient than models that simply meet the federal minimum standard for energy efficiency.

**Applicability:** New construction and retrofit installations are eligible for an incentive via a post-purchase application process.

**Equipment Eligibility:** Equipment must be purchased and installed in a facility with electric water heating, and meet all other program terms and conditions. Incentives are available for equipment that meets or exceeds the Pacific Power’s Home Energy Savings program efficiency requirements. Clothes washers must have a Modified Energy Factor (MEF) of at least 2.2 with a Water Factor (WF) no greater than 4.5 to be eligible.

1. Dated sales receipt/invoice with retailer/contractor name, address and phone number.
2. Itemized listing of quantity, description, manufacturer, model number and other indentifying information as appropriate.

**ELECTRIC WATER HEATER (RESIDENTIAL USED IN BUSINESS)**

**Measure Description:** An electric water heater uses electricity to heat potable water for use outside the heater. Energy-efficient storage water heaters have higher levels of insulation around the tank, substantially reducing standby heat loss.

**Applicability:** New construction and retrofit installations are eligible for incentive via a post-purchase application process.

**Equipment Eligibility:** Equipment must be purchased and installed at a business, and meet all other program terms and conditions. Incentives are available for equipment that meets or exceeds the Pacific Power’s Home Energy Savings program efficiency requirements. The capacity of the residential electric water heater must be 40 gallons or larger and be on the qualified products list.

1. Dated sales receipt/invoice with retailer/contractor name, address and phone number.
2. Itemized listing of quantity, description, manufacturer, model number and other indentifying information as appropriate.
3. Serial number of water heater.
4. A current copy of the Pacific Power utility bill for the address where the item(s) are installed.

**ROOM AIR CONDITIONER (RESIDENTIAL USED IN BUSINESS)**

**Measure Description:** A room air conditioner is a consumer product designed for mounting in a window or through the wall in order to deliver conditioned air to an enclosed space. ENERGY STAR® qualified models use about 10% less energy than conventional models.

**Applicability:** New construction and retrofit installations are eligible for incentive via a post-purchase application process.

**Equipment Eligibility:** Equipment must be purchased and installed at a business, and meet all other program terms and conditions. Incentives are available for equipment that meets or exceeds the Pacific Power’s Home Energy Savings program efficiency requirements. Room air conditioners must be ENERGY STAR qualified and listed on the ENERGY STAR website at the time of purchase.

**REFRIGERATOR / FREEZER RECYCLING (RESIDENTIAL USED IN BUSINESS)**

**Measure Description:** Refrigerators and freezers built prior to 1990 can use two to three times more energy than a high-efficiency one built today. By discontinuing the use of second refrigerator and/or freezer and participating in the program you can save money on your energy bill and protect the environment. The refrigerator/freezer will be properly recycled and about 95% of it will be reused.

**Applicability:** Business customers are eligible for incentive through Pacific Power’s “See ya later, refrigerator®” program.

**Equipment Eligibility:** Equipment must meet all program terms and conditions. Residential refrigerators and freezers used in a business must be in working order and must have a minimum internal volume of 10 cubic feet (ft<sup>3</sup>) or more. Pacific Power has contracted with JACO, an appliance recycler, to pickup refrigerators and freezers. Customer must own the unit(s) being recycled. Limited to two (2) recycled units per address.

**CEILING FANS (RESIDENTIAL USED IN A BUSINESS)**

**Measure Description:** A ceiling fan circulates air throughout a space, resulting in a more uniform temperature. As a result, you can reduce your air conditioner or heating system without sacrificing comfort. ENERGY STAR qualified ceiling fans with lighting kits containing compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs) save energy compared to ceiling fans with incandescent lamps.

**Applicability:** New construction and retrofit installations are eligible for incentive via a post-purchase application process.

**Equipment Eligibility:** Equipment must be purchased and installed, and meet all other program terms and conditions. Incentives are available for equipment that meets or exceeds the Pacific Power’s Home Energy Savings program efficiency requirements. Ceiling fans and lighting kits must be ENERGY STAR® qualified.
