



- Elevating Engagement input results and review as well as the results of the Community Based Renewable Energy surveys.



- Site visits to conduct feasibility studies for potential charging sites



Transportation Electrification Phase 1: Needs Assessment

- Conduct a comprehensive needs assessment within tribal communities to understand transportation challenges, preferences, and potential barriers to EV adoption.
- Learn about what program elements may be desired by Tribes to accelerate Transportation Electrification learning, adoption, and practice.
- Determine what barriers may exist to participation to address and/or rank.
- Engage to gather input on their preferred forms of support-to-support capacity building for these communities.
