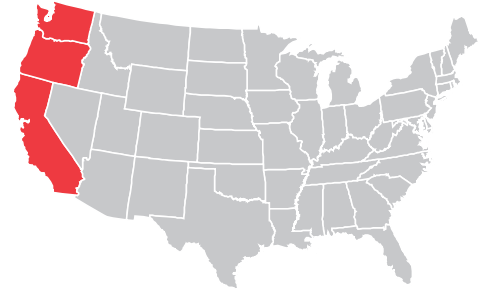

Pacific Power, a division of PacifiCorp, serves more than 783,000 customers in 243 communities across Oregon, Washington and California. Founded in 1910, Pacific Power is headquartered in Portland, Oregon. The company supplies customers with electricity from a diverse portfolio of generating plants, including hydroelectric, natural gas, coal, geothermal, and increasingly from wind and solar resources.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESPECT

- To accelerate the company’s affordable and clean energy vision, PacifiCorp recently added 1,075 megawatts of wind capacity, bringing its total owned wind capacity to 2,160 megawatts.
- The company’s long-term plan to deliver low-cost, reliable power includes big steps to reduce carbon emissions by over 50% from 2005 levels by 2030 and 90% by 2050.



CUSTOMER INNOVATION

- Customers can access a variety of digital tools to manage energy needs and stay informed during power outages, including by text alert, via email or through the company’s app.
- Nearly 140,000 participants in Pacific Power’s pioneering Blue SkySM renewable energy program collectively supported 1,268,586 megawatt-hours of renewable energy in 2020, which is enough to power 126,757 homes for a year.

- A partnership with Facebook and state and local community leaders enabled a data center expansion in Oregon and a new data center in Eagle Mountain, Utah – both supported by 100% renewable energy.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP

- The Pacific Power Foundation, the philanthropic arm of the company, contributed more than \$1 million in grants to charitable organizations and COVID-19 relief efforts in local communities.
- To encourage electric vehicle adoption and economic development, Pacific Power has teamed up with 60 businesses and communities to improve access to EV charging infrastructure in underserved areas.

OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE

- Pacific Power led the way to a transformative western U.S. energy market that maximizes renewable energy, lowers customer costs and improves grid reliability. Since starting in late 2014, the real-time energy market has saved PacifiCorp customers more than \$275 million.
- To bolster reliability in Lincoln City, Oregon, Pacific Power is developing a next generation network solution that allows the grid itself to sense outages and instantly isolate damage and reroute power.
