




# JUST THE FACTS

## PACIFIC POWER

Pacific Power, a division of PacifiCorp, serves 800,000 customers in communities across Oregon, Washington and California. Founded in 1910, Pacific Power is headquartered in Portland, Oregon. The company supplies customers with electricity from a diverse portfolio of generating plants, including hydroelectric, natural gas, coal, geothermal, and increasingly from wind and solar resources.



## ENVIRONMENTAL RESPECT

- By 2032, PacifiCorp plans to significantly increase its wind and solar resources to a total of 20,000 megawatts.
- More than 141,000 participants in Pacific Power's pioneering Blue Sky® renewable energy program collectively supported 1,015,494 megawatt-hours of renewable energy in 2022, enough to power 98,976 homes for a year.
- The company is helping interconnect 64 megawatts of solar resources through the Oregon Community Solar Program. These projects provide an easy way for all customers to share in the benefits of local solar energy production.



## CUSTOMER INNOVATION

- Customers have a variety of digital tools for energy usage information and access to bill-threshold alerts to help them better control energy costs.

- Pacific Power is partnering with communities to leverage solar-plus-storage technology. Through a partnership with the Oregon Institute of Technology in Klamath Falls, Oregon, the company is installing a 2-megawatt peak capacity, 6-megawatt-hour energy storage system that will join with the existing geothermal and solar resources on campus to provide increased local grid stability.
- To encourage electric vehicle adoption and economic development, Pacific Power has installed 20 fast chargers in underserved areas and has teamed up with more than 80 businesses and communities to improve access to EV charging infrastructure.



## COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP

- Through Pacific Power Foundation grants, corporate giving and employees' contributions, we've given \$13 million to local communities since 2017.
- Company employees once again teamed up with the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife in July 2022 to help give hundreds of kids with disabilities a day of fun and fishing at the Merwin Fish Hatchery in Woodland, Washington.
- Together with communities, Pacific Power is gathering broad public input as it invests in clean energy resources and builds the grid of the future to ensure all customers thrive.



## OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE

- Pacific Power is expanding investments not typically associated with energy services providers including by adding a full-time meteorology team that advances our weather forecasting and predictive modeling capabilities. The company is also hiring additional emergency managers, continuing its investments in system hardening and enhancing vegetation management practices in areas at high risk for wildfires.
