PacifiCorp's Energy Gateway represents 2,300 miles of new high-voltage transmission lines, including in Oregon.

The project includes the Boardman to Hemingway line (with Idaho Power) and the Wallula to McNary line into southeast Washington. These segments will help connect even more power for Oregonians.
