Blue SkySM Business Partner Program

To reward your business for supporting renewable energy through the Blue Sky program, we offer a business partnership program. This program recognizes organizations that commit to a Blue Sky renewable energy purchase that meets or exceeds minimum purchase requirements based on your electricity usage. The business partnership program currently has hundreds of partners who are voluntarily supporting renewable energy. Please see the back of this form for samples of some of the materials that may help get the word out about your efforts to hasten renewable energy development.

When joining the Blue Sky business partnership, you have the flexibility to choose whether your entire organization or a facility within your organization becomes a partner. This flexibility allows you to fine tune your renewable energy purchase.

A minimum purchase level and a one-year commitment are required to participate in the business partnership program.

Champion	10% of load or 10 blocks, whichever is greater <i>(a 350 monthly block purchase will qualify a business as a Champion level partner)</i>	\$19.50 – \$370.00
Supporter	Over 10,000 kilowatt-hours/month (7 blocks)	\$13.65

Blue Sky solar projects

Blue Sky customers help bring solar to Roseburg food bank

When Blue Sky partners business partner, United Community Action Network (UCAN), set out to build the Joyce Morgan Regional Food Bank, they knew from the start that renewable energy would be an important component. UCAN, a Roseburg, Oregon based community action agency, contacted their renewed food bank in 2008 with the help from generous donors. Although they had not secured their resources to incorporate renewable energy at the time of construction, UCAN built the food bank "solar ready" with the hope that a rooftop photovoltaic system could be installed when funding was available. Four years later, with the help of Blue Sky community project funds and **Energy Fund of Oregon**, the Joyce Morgan Regional Food Bank has achieved its goal and completed the installation of a 100-panel, 27.4 kilowatt (KW) roof-mounted solar array. This system is expected to provide roughly 10 percent of the building's energy needs and has decreased the building's energy bill by nearly 67 percent in the first three months of operation.

The food bank is a part of the Douglas County Food Bank Network, which distributes food to food assistance to tens of thousands of Southern Oregonians every month. "Energy conservation is very important to us," said UCAN's Resource Development Director Andrea Burnett. "Investing solar allows us to save money that can be used for other important services." In addition to generating on-site renewable energy at the food bank, UCAN has solicited more than 100 units of affordable housing and has a green team focused on promoting sustainability within the organization.

This installation in UCAN's second community project to receive Blue Sky funding in 2010, UCAN received Blue Sky community project funds to help install a 23.6 KW solar system on the roof of the Martha Young Family Service Building, which supplies roughly 10 percent of the building's energy needs.
