Engagement Space Feedback

During the previous review cycle, we heard feedback across two categories.

Clarity of the report

- Help clarify LC82 and its impact on this report
- Provide a 1-2 page summary of the report
- Better define the purpose and add intentionality to the report
- Aim to use language that tells the story in a way sharing the impacts of the CBIAG

Changes made:

 Created an adapted summary to reflect the elements requested by advisors

Opportunities to include additional topics

- A glossary to help make it easier to navigate
- Inclusions of additional technical topics
- Additional data tables to tell the story
- Information on topics such as rates, wildfires, etc.
- Provide more information on the shared values of the CBIAG and emphasize the newness of the process

Changes made:

 Glossary added to define acronyms and energy specific terms
