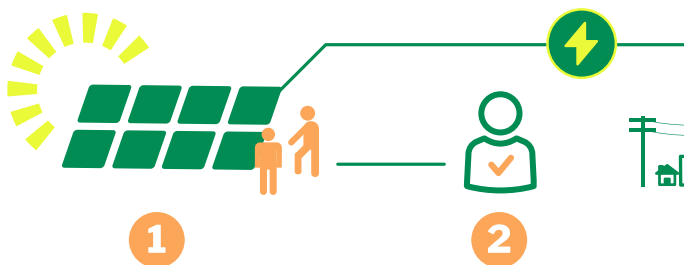
Solar energy for everyone.

Solar projects can be managed by developers, nonprofits, homeowners' associations and community organizations. You can choose from a variety of projects based on your needs and preferences. Subscriptions vary in price, and many can lower your monthly bill.

Project Managers build and operate community solar projects.

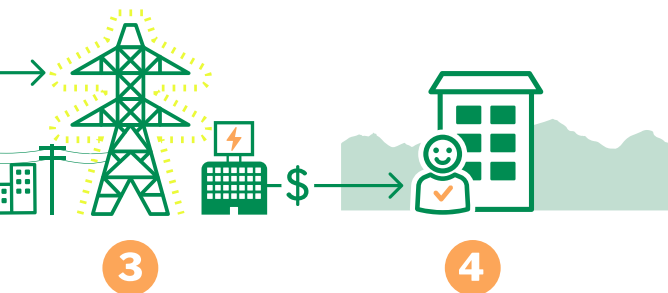
