
Step 2: Follow the Login Prompts to start the setup process

Step 4: Finish Setting Up Your Account

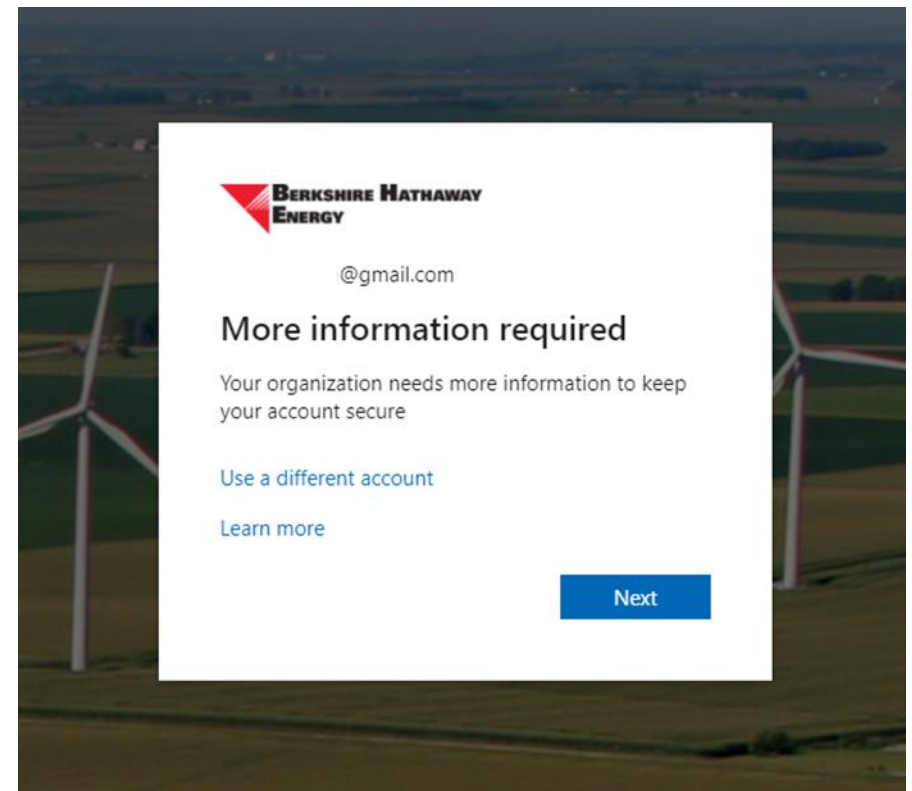
Click the **Get Started** link in the automated email you received and follow the login prompts.



STEP 5: Accept Permissions from Berkshire Hathaway Energy

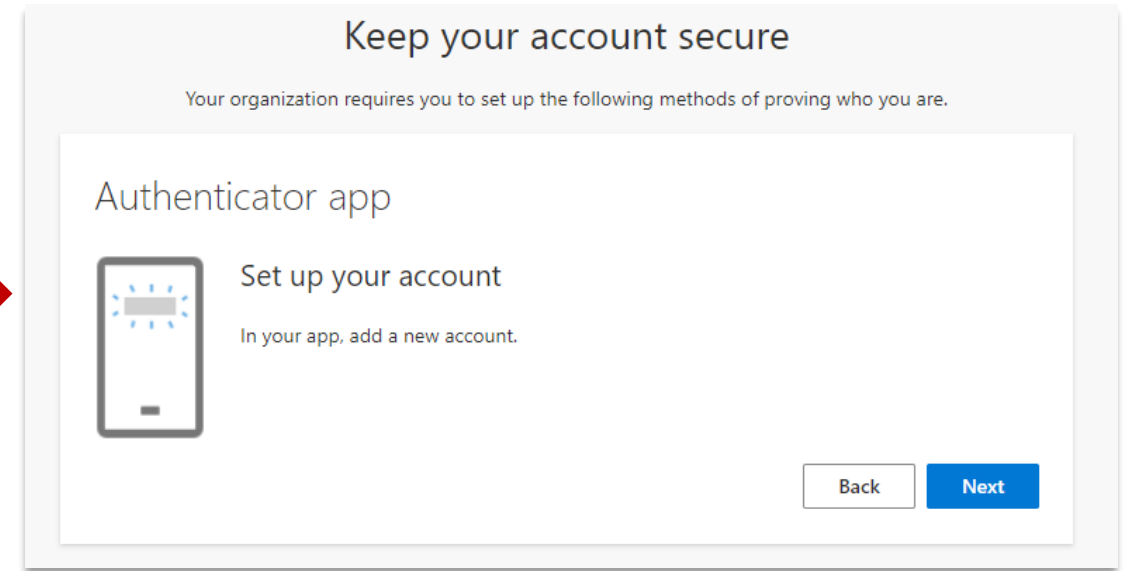
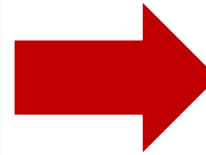
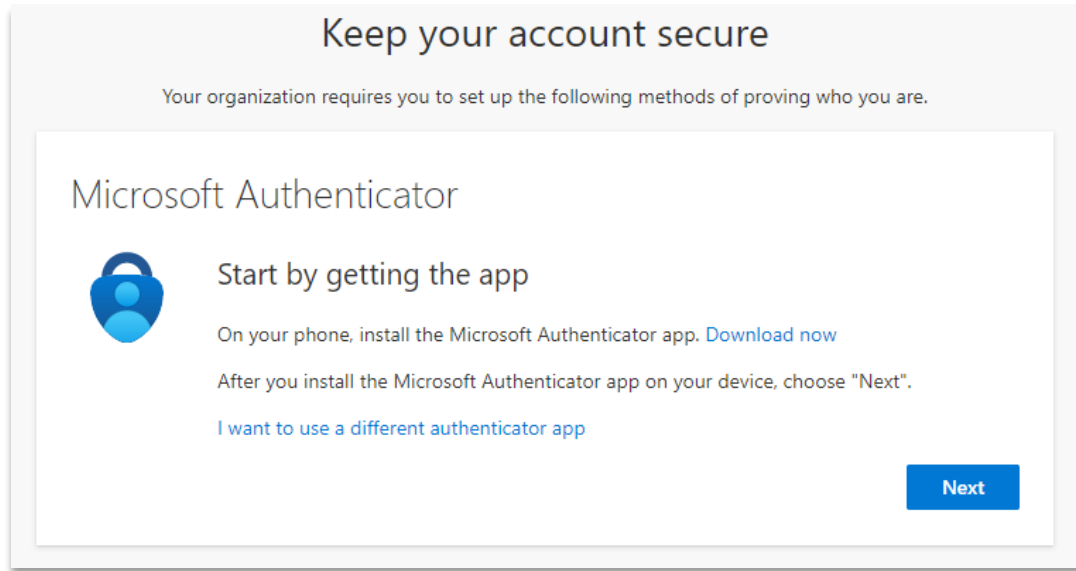


Once you click **Accept**, a new window will prompt you for more information. Click **Next**.
