PURPOSE

PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power (PacifiCorp or Company) submits Advice Letter 608-E in compliance with California Public Utilities Commission Decision (D.) 18-09-034, which directs utilities to file—within 18 months of the decision—an Advice Letter describing compliance efforts with the safety requirements checklist.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

In Senate Bill (SB) 350, the California Legislature required the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission)—in consultation with the California Air Resources Board (CARB), and the California Energy Commission (CEC)—to direct utilities to undertake TE activities consistent with Public Utilities Code Sections 237.5 and 740.12.¹

The September 14, 2016 Assigned Commissioner’s Ruling (ACR) specified that projects should be either priority review programs or standard review programs and defined the criteria for each. Priority review programs were to be non-controversial and limited in budget and duration, while standard review projects could have longer durations and potentially larger budgets.

On June 30, 2017, PacifiCorp filed Application (A.) 17-06-031 and supporting direct testimony proposing two Senate Bill (SB) 350 priority review programs:

- **Outreach and Education Program** – designed to increase awareness of electric vehicle (EV) options in PacifiCorp’s California service territory; and

- **Demonstration and Development Program** – which would award competitive grant funding to non-residential customers to encourage the development of customer-driven TE projects in PacifiCorp’s California service territory.

PacifiCorp requested priority review treatment of these programs as they were non-controversial, had limited durations (i.e., one year), and were limited in budget (i.e., \$440k in aggregate), which is well under the \$4 million individual program cap and \$20 million aggregate cap established in the ACR.

On April 13, 2018, PacifiCorp, California Office of Public Advocate (CalPA, formerly ORA), and Small Business Utility Advocates (SBUA) filed a joint motion for Commission consideration which settled issues in PacifiCorp’s application. Decision 18-09-034 approved the implementation of PacifiCorp’s Education and Outreach and Demonstration and Development priority review programs as well as the joint parties’ settlement agreement.

The September 14, 2016 ACR encouraged projects that—among other requirements—promote driver, customer, and worker safety. In support of this, Safety and Enforcement Division staff developed a Safety Requirements Checklist, which consolidates current standards and requirements in one place and ensures that infrastructure is installed and operated safely and does not adversely affect reliability of electrical service.

PacifiCorp’s priority review projects approved by D.18-09-034 are compliant with the Safety Requirements Checklist, and PacifiCorp has instituted compliance efforts to align with the Safety Requirements Checklist.

PacifiCorp does not plan to directly build, own or operate any electric vehicle charging stations through approved priority review projects. In regards to the Outreach and Education Pilot, the company has directed the technical assistance service vendor, C2 Group, to follow the Safety Requirements Checklist in regards to technical assistance reports provided to customers.

In regards to the Demonstration and Development Pilot, the company will ask any grant funding recipients to comply with the Safety Requirements Checklist alongside the grant funding agreement. Grant recipients will be asked to return a form stating they understand and will follow Safety Requirements Checklist prior to receiving grant funding for their project.

TIER DESIGNATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This Advice Letter is submitted as a Tier 1 filing, as directed in D.18-09-034. PacifiCorp respectfully requests that this Advice Letter become effective March 27, 2020, the same day the Advice Letter is filed.




