**RE: PacifiCorp (U 901-E) Information-Only Advice Letter 735-E
Hunter Coal Supply Agreement**

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Tier 1 information-only advice letter is to provide notice that PacifiCorp has recently signed a contract amendment for a coal supply agreement supplying the Hunter Plant.

BACKGROUND

On September 18, 2015, PacifiCorp filed Application (A.) 15-09-007, seeking approval from the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) in accordance with Pub. Util. Code § 851, to sell certain mining assets. Parties to the proceeding held a settlement conference on November 1, 2016, executed an all-party Settlement Agreement, and on February 6, 2017, jointly moved for Adoption of the Settlement Agreement (All-Party Settlement). The All-Party Settlement was adopted in Decision (D.) 18-09-008. The Company submits this Advice Letter pursuant to the terms of the All-Party Settlement, which states in Section 2.3:

“Section 2.3 provides that PacifiCorp will submit a Tier 1 Advice Letter to the Commission as an information-only filing giving notice if PacifiCorp enters into any new coal supply agreement for the Hunter or Huntington Plants with a term of five or more years. The Advice Letter will identify the ratemaking proceeding in which the new coal supply agreement will be addressed, and will be served on Sierra Club and ORA.”

Though PacifiCorp did not sign a *new* coal supply agreement for the Hunter Plant with a term of five or more years, the Company provides this notice of contract amendment to parties.

Contract Amendment – Hunter

On February 15, 2024, PacifiCorp signed an amendment to the existing two-year (2024-2025) coal supply agreement with Wolverine Fuels, which would extend the contract by an additional five years (2026-2030). The coal supply agreement amendment with Wolverine for the Hunter

Plant will be addressed in further detail in the energy cost adjustment clause (ECAC) proceeding which PacifiCorp anticipates filing in August 2024.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This advice letter is submitted as a Tier 1 filing. PacifiCorp respectfully requests that this Advice Letter become effective March 14, 2024.

As an information-only advice filing, Advice Letter 735-E is not subject to protest pursuant to General Order 96-B, Section 6.2.




