

**Pacific Power Microbusiness Customer  
Self-Certification Affidavit**

In accordance with California Public Utilities Commission Decisions (D.) D. 10-10-032 and D. 10-11-037, Small Business Customers may benefit from certain deposit and back billing rules that apply to residential customers. If your business' usage was 40,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) or less, or monthly demand was 20 kW or less during the previous 12 months, your business is automatically qualified to benefit from these deposit and back billing rules. If your business does not meet the above usage or demand criteria, or Pacific Power does not have 12 months of data available, your business may qualify for these deposit and back billing rules using the definition of "microbusiness" in Section 14837 of the California Government Code.

By signing this affidavit you are declaring your business meets the definition of a microbusiness according to California Government Code Section 14837, and further more you are requesting Pacific Power designate your account as a Small Business Customer. Please contact Pacific Power toll free at 1-888-221-7070 if you have any additional questions regarding this affidavit or the Small Business Customer definition. Upon receipt of this signed affidavit, Pacific Power will designate your account as a Small Business Customer. It is the responsibility of the customer or an authorized representative of the customer to notify Pacific Power if your status as a microbusiness changes.
