EXPEDITED MOTION FOR GENERAL PROTECTIVE ORDER

Expedited Consideration Requested

Under ORCP 36(C)(7) and OAR 860-001-0080(1), PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power 1 2 (PacifiCorp or Company) moves the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) for 3 entry of a general protective order in the Investigation to Determine the Resource Value of 4 Solar proceeding. Good cause exists to issue a Protective Oder to protect commercially 5 sensitive and confidential business information in this proceeding. 6 The Commission's rules authorize PacifiCorp to seek reasonable restrictions on discovery of trade secrets and other confidential business information. The Commission's 7 8 general protective order is designed to allow the broadest possible discovery consistent with the need to protect confidential information.² PacifiCorp requests this protective order to 9 facilitate the communication of information between the parties and expedite the discovery 10 11 process.
