
Consumer's Load and Operations

Consumer shall provide devices adequate to protect its equipment from high and low voltage, and from overload, and from the effects of "single phasing" of a three-phase delivery, and shall make no material addition to, or change in, its electrical facilities without Company's agreement that the additional or changed load is of such a size and has such characteristics that service can be furnished without detriment to other Consumers or damage to Company's facilities. Consumer shall provide the necessary control equipment which will, to the Company's satisfaction, eliminate excessive starting current or undesirable voltage fluctuations on Company's circuits.
